CHOOSE LOVE

Program started by Scarlett Lewis and a group of educators. Scarlett was inspired by the death of her son, six year old Jesse Lewis. He was murdered on December 14, 2012 alongside 19 of his classmates and six educators in the Sandy Hook Elementary Shooting.

CHOOSING LOVE AT GMMS

Students and teachers completed a personal characteristics profile

- Students were grouped with teachers they would feel most comfortable with.
- Small groups of 9–10 students
- Meet every three weeks for 37 minutes as a small group
- Complete one Power Surge in between each Brain Blast

CHOOSE LOVE

Program Overview

- Four units
 - Courage, Gratitude, Forgiveness & Compassion
- Seven Brain Blast and 28 Power surges per unit

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

Important aspect of SEL is parental involvement

Each Brain Blast is communicated to parents about the topic and things to follow up at home.
