

Great Meadows Middle School School Health-related Closure Preparedness Plan

INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN

1. Teachers will provide instruction through online textbooks and programs (HMH Dimensions, Big Ideas Math, IXL Math and ELA), Google Classroom, video instruction, email, and web-based resources. All teachers at Great Meadows Middle School have access to quality online materials and resources and are trained in the use of these methods. Additionally, teachers have the option of providing paper-based assignments for those without internet access.
2. All teachers have access to Google Apps for Education and Google accounts. This allows for tracking of assignments, communication between teacher and student/parents, and time-stamped due dates.
3. In the event of advance warning of a closure, teachers will send textbooks and paper-based materials home along with other needed supplies with students for accessibility during closure.

EQUITABLE ACCESS TO INSTRUCTION

1. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch, as well as students that do not have technology to access assignments may be provided district-issued Chromebooks for instruction at home.
2. Students in this category will also be given hard-copies of all textbooks and available workbooks to use at home.
3. In the event a school closure occurs without advance notice, administrative and support staff will be available at the school to distribute the materials needed for equitable access to instruction.
4. In the event a student is unable to access the internet, the student will not be penalized for missed assignments and will be afforded reasonable time to make up work upon return to school.
5. Free and reduced lunch students will be provided daily lunch meals which can be picked up at Great Meadows Middle School Administrative Offices.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

1. All IEP and 504 Plan modifications and accommodations will be provided to students through assignments posted on Google Classroom or hard copies.
2. Teachers will continue to provide modified coursework, testing, and materials to all students who qualify for those services.
3. Students requiring extended time for assignments will be given extended-time based on a school day schedule
