What is our Academic Support Program?

- GMRSD receives federal funding to provide programs that help us assist students who are struggling as well as provide enrichment to students who are proficient, but would benefit from focused instruction.
- We are required to develop entrance & exit criteria as well as illicit interest from the staff.
- We are required to host this parent involvement meeting to discuss the program and our School-Parent Compact.
- The programs are optional.



Title I Grant

For the 20-23-24 school year, GMRSD will be using grant funds for academic support clubs. The two main benefits to the district are:

- All students are able to participate in these programs, regardless of academic need.
- The Title I funds were used to retain a Title I teacher at Central School. This allows the district to provide support during the school day for students in need of academic interventions.
