COMMON FEELINGS, THOUGHTS, AND BEHAVIORS OF THE GRIEVING CHILD

- 1. The child **retells events** of the deceased's death and funeral.
- 2. The child **dreams** of the deceased.
- 3. The child **feels the deceased is with him or her** in some way.
- 4. The child **rejects old friends and seeks new friends** who have experienced a similar loss.
- 5. The child wants to call home during the school day.
- 6. The child **can't concentrate** on homework or class work.
- 7. The child **bursts into tears** in the middle of class.
- 8. The child **seeks medical information** on death of deceased.
- 9. The child **worries excessively** about his or her own health.
- 10. The child sometimes **appears to be unfeeling** about the loss.
- 11. The child **becomes the "class clown"** to get attention.
- 12. The child **is overly concerned** with caretaking needs.
