PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Keeps the classrooms, offices, building and premises, including sidewalks, driveways, and play areas neat and clean at all times.
- 2. Operates heat, ventilation, air exchange systems to provide appropriate temperatures for all seasons to ensure economical and efficient use of fuel, water, and electricity.
- 3. Checks daily, that all exit doors, security measures, alarm systems, before locking the building.

- 4. Cleans, mops, wipes, dusts, sweeps, vacuums, polishes, washes, and empties trash of offices, classrooms, instructional areas, cafeteria, and all other rooms in the school and assists other work crews or vendors in these tasks.

- 9. Complies with all laws, regulations, and codes in regards to trash removal, removal of hazardous material, storage of such, volatile chemicals, and dangerous substances.
- 10. Obeys and enforces all fire, safety, discipline, procedural, environmental, and compliance codes and regulations that govern the safe and efficient operation of the school.
